Re: Expansion of Tobacco Cessation Coverage

This provider bulletin is being issued to notify providers that Nebraska Medicaid is expanding its tobacco cessation program to include group counseling, **effective July 1, 2024.**

Tobacco cessation group counseling will be billed under the title "Intensive Counseling" using code 99407. This will cover the individual in a group counseling session that is longer than 10 minutes. Providers must use the HQ modifier to indicate the group session.

Nebraska Medicaid has covered tobacco cessation counseling for individual (1/1) coverage since 2022. The information in this bulletin supersedes that shared in Provider Bulletin 22-06.

The following requirements to receive cessation products will remain in effect:

- The member must be 18 years of age or older.
- Products must be FDA-approved and used according to FDA dosing and age guidelines.
- The product must be provided using a prescription.
- A maximum of eight counseling sessions are allowed per year. These appointments can be a combination of the following CPT codes:

Intermediate: 99406Intensive: 99407

Intensive Group: 99407 HQ

The Nebraska Tobacco Quitline offers a broad range of cessation support resources for patients who want to quit tobacco. Combined with ongoing monitoring, support, and treatment, referring beneficiaries to a Quitline or other cessation resource can improve their chances of quitting.
