Re: Pharmacy Dispensing Fee Rate Increase

This provider bulletin is being issued to notify Nebraska Medicaid pharmacy providers of upcoming changes to the pharmacy professional dispensing fee rate effective July 1, 2025. This update is being made as a result of a statutorily-required pharmacy dispensing fee study as mandated per [Nebraska Revised Statute 68-9,111](#) (2024).

Independent pharmacies who fill a prescription for a Nebraska Medicaid managed care member will receive a professional dispensing fee rate increase from \$10.38 to \$10.50 for prescriptions dispensed on or after July 1, 2025.

All pharmacies who fill a prescription for a Nebraska Medicaid fee-for-service (FFS) member will receive a professional dispensing fee rate increase from \$10.38 to \$10.50 for prescriptions dispensed on or after July 1, 2025.

Per Nebraska Revised Statute 68-9,111, independent pharmacies are defined as those who own six or fewer pharmacies.

Long-term care pharmacy providers will continue to receive one dispensing fee per month per prescription for services provided to nursing and intermediate care facilities.

Tribal rates will continue to be reimbursed at the federal encounter rate.
