Re: Updated Service Definition and Changes to Billing and Utilization of Applied Behavior Analysis Services

This provider bulletin is being issued to clarify guidance on billing and utilization of applied behavior analysis (ABA) services, and to notify providers of changes to coverage requirements, **beginning July 1, 2026.**

ABA services provided in a school setting

ABA services are included in school-based services reimbursement, and are the responsibility of the school as outlined in Nebraska Administrative Code Title 471, Chapter 25 and the Medicaid State Plan. Independent providers may not bill Medicaid directly for services provided at a school. Services provided by the school must meet the service definition requirements for Applied Behavior Analysis defined by Medicaid and Long-Term Care.

ABA services for individuals receiving services from the Division of Developmental Disabilities

The following coverage changes will apply to dates of service on and after July 1, 2026:

Individuals who are receiving waiver services from the Division of Developmental Disabilities may receive Applied Behavior Analysis Assessments (HCPCS codes 97151 and 97152), regardless of age. For waiver recipients only, the ABA assessment may be recommended and used for non-ABA related purposes. The ABA assessment must meet all other service definition requirements outlined by Medicaid and Long-Term Care for the ABA assessment.

ABA Updated Service Definitions

The 2026 updates to the Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) Medicaid Service Definitions (MSDs) for Nebraska Medicaid will be posted to the Medicaid and Long-Term Care website at <https://dhhs.ne.gov/Pages/Medicaid-Behavioral-Health-Definitions.aspx>.
