
SUBJECT: Caregiver Information & Assistance

CONTENT: The SUA is making changes to ensure that Caregiver Information & Assistance services, which are being provided to Older Relative Caregivers and Family Caregivers, are being

tracked accurately.

In order to accurately attribute units of Caregiver Information & Assistance to Family Caregivers versus Older Relative Caregivers, in PeerPlace, there will need to be two Event Descriptions for this service. One Event Description for Older Relative Caregivers and one for Family Caregivers.

For Caregiver Information & Assistance services being provided beginning 1/1/2024, please ensure that your agency has two event descriptions – one for Family Caregivers and One for Older Relative Caregivers. This distinction will be made by funding source. The two different funding sources will be III-E Family Caregiver and III-E Relative Caregiver. This can be found under the Funder drop-down box in the event details. Please see below:

Please keep track of units of Caregiver Information & Assistance as provided to Family Caregivers and Older Relative Caregivers and then enter them into the appropriate Event Description. Caregiver Information & Assistance is a Non-Registered Service that can be provided anonymously, therefore, information to determine whether the caregiver is a Family Caregiver versus an Older Relative Caregiver may not be able to be obtained. In this instance, please attribute the unit of service to Family Caregiver.
