

Nebraskans Will Soon Be Able to Download Immunization Records to their Smartphones

The Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) is excited to announce the upcoming launch of a new feature on the Nebraska State Immunization Information System (NESIIS), which will give Nebraskans the ability to download their immunization records to a mobile phone.

Beginning June 10, 2024, Nebraskans will have the option to securely download their (or their child's) immunization information from NESIIS to their Android or iOS mobile device, enabling the option to share immunization records quickly and easily with healthcare providers, schools, and other organizations.
