EXECUTIVE ORDER 21-15 TIME-LIMITED PROVISIONAL LICENSE INFORMATION

On October 13, 2021, Nebraska Governor Pete Ricketts issued Executive Order 21-12 (expiring December 31, 2021) which provides waivers of specific statutes and applicable regulations to ensure that Nebraskans retain access to needed healthcare professionals. One of those waivers relates to submitting your examination results required for licensure.

Examination: If you meet all licensing requirements for a permanent license, but have not passed the examination, you can be issued a time-limited provisional license pending successful examination results or the duration of the emergency (December 31, 2021), whichever is shorter.

The time-limited provisional license expires:

- If you pass the examination, the Department will issue your permanent license; OR
- If the Department has not received your passing score by December 31, 2021. You cannot continue to practice until you pass the examination and are issued a permanent license.

To request a time-limited provisional license under EO 21-15, complete the following:
