



## Summary of Suicide Deaths in Nebraska Among Those Who Disclosed Suicidal Intent



## **Other Decedent Characteristics** Statistics are based on 130 cases. of total suicide deaths took place in a 70.8% residence. of total suicide victims experienced 13.1% homelessness or housing instability. of total suicide victims had previous mental 48.5% health problems. of total suicide victims were diagnosed 36.9% with depression. of total suicide victims were diagnosed 10.8% with bipolar disorder or anxiety disorder. of total suicide victims had history of 30.0% mental health treatment. of total suicide victims had current mental 20.0% health treatment. of total suicide victims were perceived by 73.8% others to be depressed at the time of death. of total suicide victims had a history of 61.5% suicidal ideation. of total suicide victims had a history of 22.3% suicide attempt. of total suicide victims had disclosed their 36.2% suicidal intent to their family member. 38.5% of total suicide victims left suicide notes. of total suicide victims had a history of 23.1% alcohol abuse. of total suicide victims had a history of 22.3% substance abuse other than alcohol. of total suicide victims had a history of 21.5% physical health problems. of total suicide victims had criminal or legal 8.5% problems. of total suicide victims had intimate partner 36.9% problems. of total suicide victims had family or other 8.5% relationship problems. of total suicide victims had known recent 21.5% argument. of the suicide deaths were among never 39.2% married individuals. of the suicide deaths were among married 29.2% individuals.
