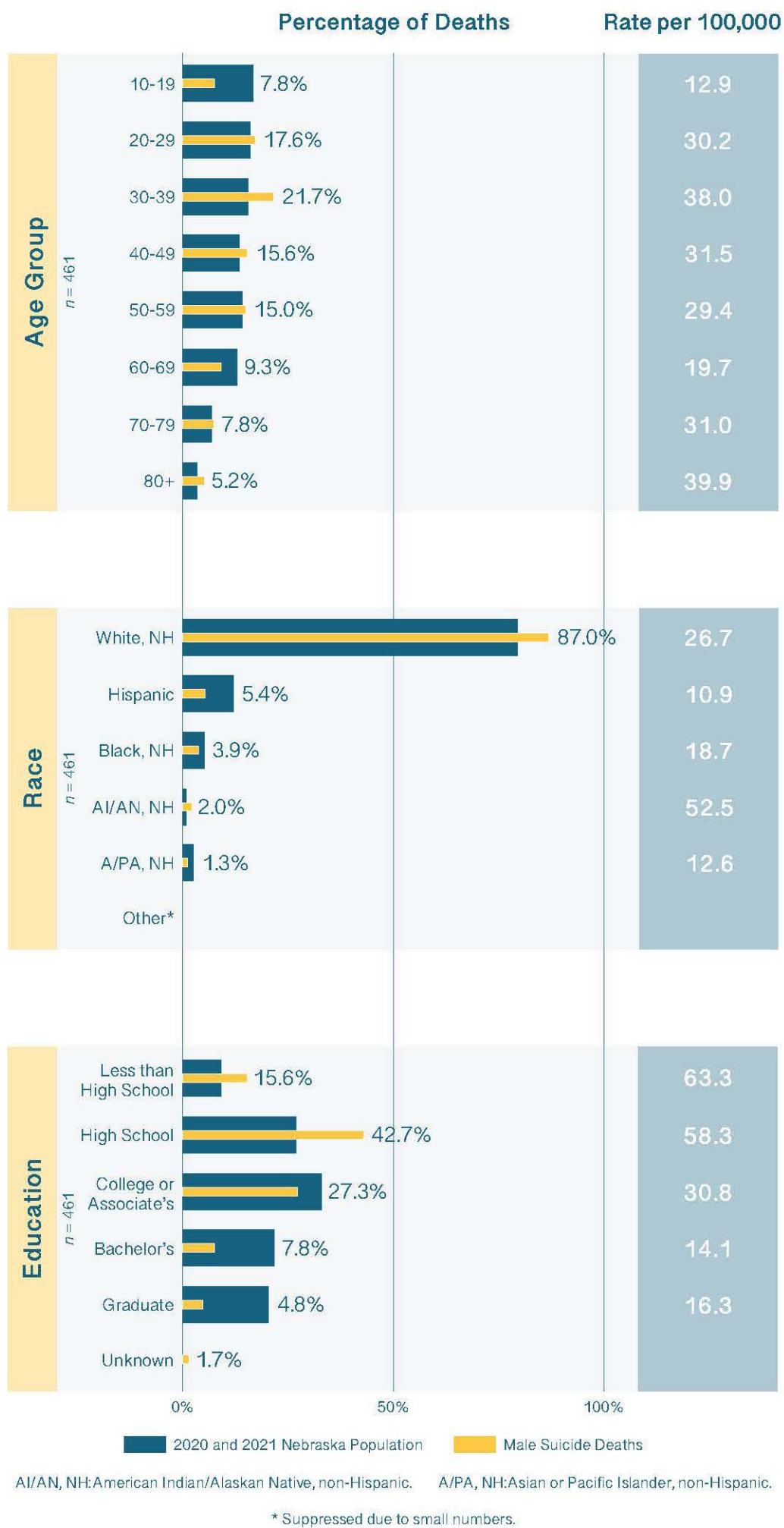


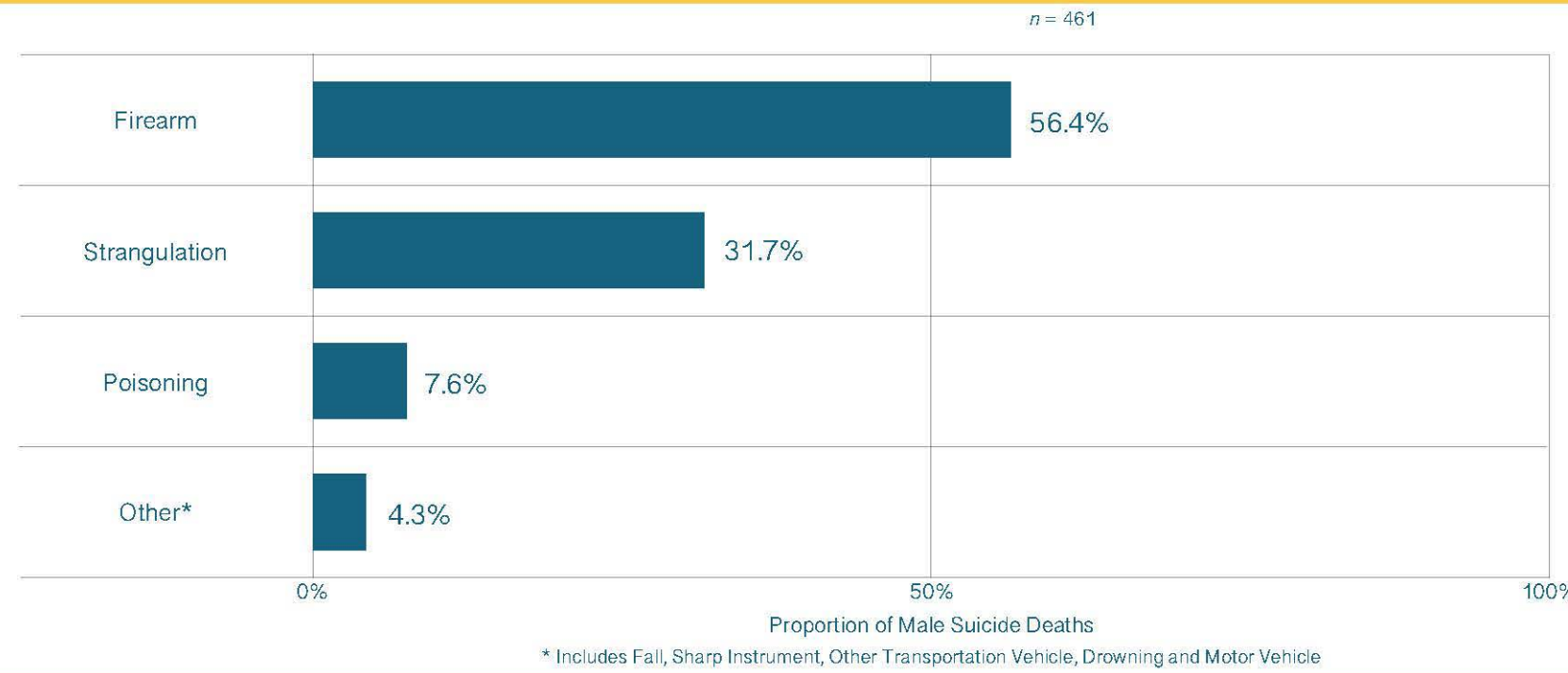

Demographic Information



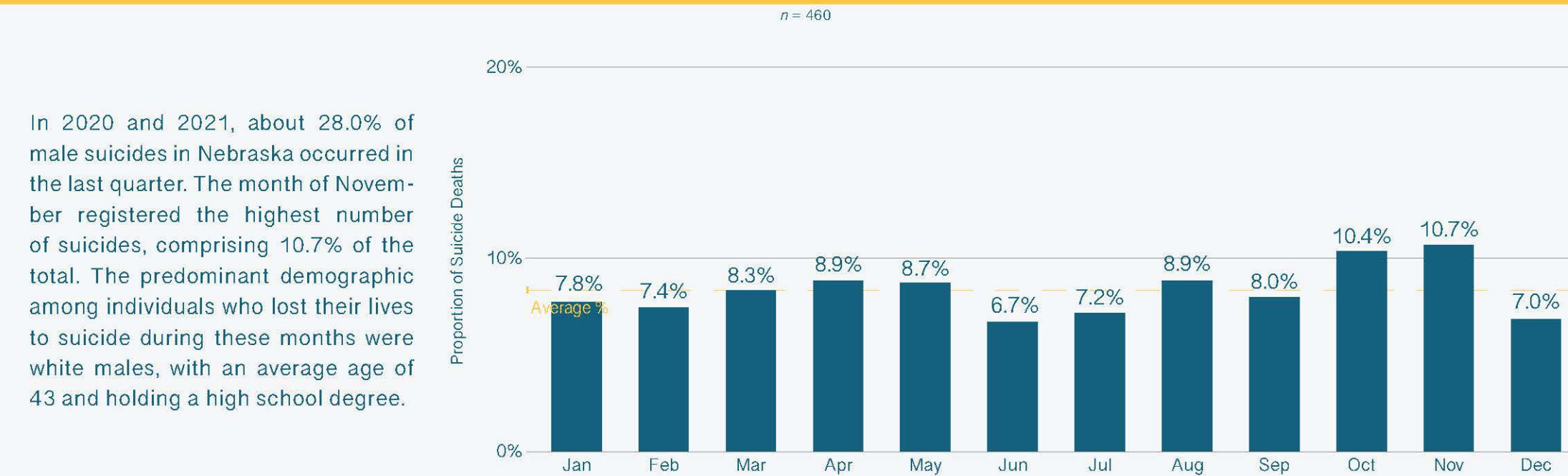
In 2020 and 2021, among male suicide victims, white males with a high school education and between the age of 30-39 years old most frequently died from suicide. American Indian/Alaska Native, Non-Hispanic and Black, Non-Hispanic males were disproportionately impacted by suicide in Nebraska.

Cause of Death



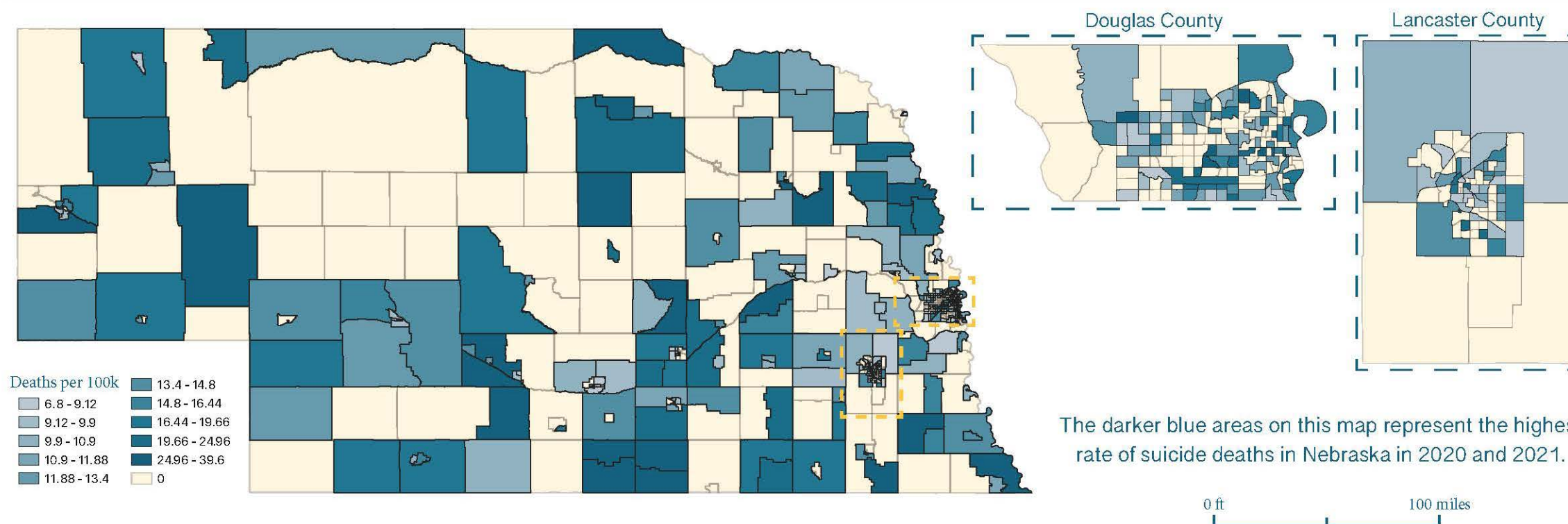
In 2020 and 2021, among males who died by suicide in Nebraska, the predominant method used by the majority of victims was firearms. The average age for firearm-related suicide deaths was 48, while strangulation occurred at an average age of 37, and poisoning (including drug overdose) at 41.

Suicide Deaths by Month



In 2020 and 2021, about 28.0% of male suicides in Nebraska occurred in the last quarter. The month of November registered the highest number of suicides, comprising 10.7% of the total. The predominant demographic among individuals who lost their lives to suicide during these months were white males, with an average age of 43 and holding a high school degree.
