Electronic Visit Verification Update – Mary McMichael

- Nearing Completion on the final Request for Proposal
 - Going through reviews
 - We are requesting an extension
 - o Implementation beginning in early 2020
 - o Agency Provider requirements will on the EVV website

No Wrong Door – Karen Houseman

- Currently No Wrong Door has been put on the back burner.
- At this point, we do not know when we will again pick up this program.
- The Aging and Disability Resource Center, (ADRC) will continue to work with all calls coming in and helping each caller with their questions.

National Core Indicators – Stephanie Crouch

- In the first year of the survey, 672 individuals from Personal Assistance Service, (PAS), Aged and Disabled Waiver, Traumatic Brain Injury Waiver, (TBI), were given the survey.
 - We will have the results the first part of 2019
- For the 2019 survey, we will survey approximately 900 individuals from all the above programs and service other than the TBI Waiver.
 - Because of the smaller number of individuals on the TBI Waiver, all were surveyed in 2017 - 2018, so we will wait a year before surveying them once again.
- We have added 10 state specific questions to the survey this year.
- We added a Person Centered Planning Module
- The survey can be completed by a proxy, or anyone chosen by the client we are surveying.

Case Management

- This is a software procurement, not changing or including any services.
- We hope to release an RFP in the first quarter 2019
- This will provide a standardized assessment for all programs
