Application for ARRT Limited Radiographer Examination

Exam Fee – The exam fee should be paid to ARRT directly. The full exam fee must be paid each time you apply to take the exam regardless of the number of exam categories you take.

Exam Dates and Times

The ARRT Limited Radiographer Exam is a self-scheduled examination. Approximately 14 days after you submit the attached application, you will receive a packet from the ARRT containing complete instructions on scheduling a test date. Test dates can usually be arranged on weekdays between 8am and 5pm. Test sites are located in Lincoln, Omaha, and North Platte. You must take your exam within the ninety-day window assigned to you by the ARRT. IF YOU DO NOT TAKE YOUR TEST WITHIN NINETY-DAYS YOU WILL FORFEIT YOUR FEE.

Exam Modules

The exam has six modules: Core (which includes questions on safety, patient care, and general radiographic procedures), Chest, Extremities*, Skull, Spine and Podiatry. To obtain a Limited Radiographer License, you must pass the Core and at least one other module. The minimum passing score is 70% for the Core and 65% for each anatomical module. You should take the modules corresponding to those areas in which you wish to be licensed. Example: a person who passes the Core, Chest, and Spine modules can apply for a license to take x-rays of the chest and spine. *The Extremities module includes the foot and ankle.

Adding Categories to a License - Additional categories can be added to an existing Limited Radiographer license by retaking and passing the appropriate sections of the ARRT exam. Licensees who want to add categories must submit this application and pay the exam fee to ARRT but do not need to pay any additional licensing fee.

Score Reports – Exam results will be mailed to you approximately four weeks after you take the test.

How many times can I take the exam?

You must pay the fee each time you take the exam. You can take the exam up to three times without restriction. When re-testing, previously passed modules do not need to be retaken. An applicant who fails to obtain a passing score on the third attempt must wait one year and complete continuing education coursework before reapplying for the exam.

Licensure

The attached application is not a license application. It is an application to take the ARRT exam only. To receive a license, you must complete an additional application after you pass the exam. All applicants who pass the core module and at least one anatomical module will be sent a license application.
