c) Advisory Positions: Esthetic Procedures (needle size for esthetic services)

Currently the Board's advisory opinion position allows for needle size of .05 (determined September 18, 2013). Companies in 2013 and prior had 10 different sizes of needles. In 2013 microneedling was a roller device (micro needling). Now there are pens that have 20-30 needles in a cartridge (like a jack hammer-better results). Current research shows companies do not sell a .05 needle, not it's a .5 mm; same for the .03 needle it now a .3. Needle sizes above .5 is a medical grade, Board will relook at the next meeting.
