- a) Body Art Regulations No updates
- b) Advisory Positions: Esthetic Procedures (needle size for esthetic services) Discussion relating to the various needle sizes offered by manufacturers (.5 or .50, .3 or .30). Further discussion related to the names of procedures whereby dozens of tiny needles are inserted into the skin, that are similar, such as: Dermarolling, Collagen Induction Therapy (CIT), and Micro needing (board to further review in August).

The Dermatologic Workgroup Final Report was briefly discussed (developed in 8/2011 by a committee

of several dermatologic related professions and adopted by the Board). The report indicates that mild peels, typically use solutions that are equal to or less than 30% glycolic acid, are acceptable for estheticians and cosmetologists. Per statute, the practice of Esthetics/Cosmetology is upon the skin (epidermis); services below the epidermis and into the dermis are not within the scope of practice.

Criswell reported that she is seeing public discussions relating to selling medical (prescription vs professional products), medical Directors / PA's in spas, and delegated medical services.

c) **Reports**: Disciplinary and Non-Disciplinary Actions, Licensure Statistics, Examination Pass/Fail Report, and Administrative Penalty Fees Assessed.
